SingleCare Card FAQs:

Can I use this for a relative who does not have insurance?

Yes, this card can be used by family members do not have Medicaid or CHIP coverage.

Is there a copay?

There is no copay. You simply pay a discounted cash price for your prescription medications.

Is there a mobile app?

Yes, you can download the SingleCare iOS or Android app. It gives you free access to the SingleCare discount program at U.S. pharmacies. The app is the fastest and easiest way to access your free, digital prescription discount card.

How do I get the discount?

SingleCare discounts are applicable to most prescription drugs, meaning you can find discounts on medications for each family member. Your family could get an average savings of 80% off prescription prices. To start saving, simply ask your pharmacist what the retail price of your prescription is. Then, use your SingleCare card to get a free discount. Repeat this process every time you pick up a refill.
