MCO Notice published March 24, 2020:

# **COVID-19 Guidance for the Consumer Directed Services (CDS) Option**

The following Medicaid and CHIP flexibilities have been extended through January 31, 2022. The notice was updated on November 18 to reflect the new extension date.

## **Background:**

In response to COVID-19, HHSC is providing guidance to MCOs and Financial Management Services Agencies (FMSAs) regarding requirements in the Consumer Direct Services (CDS) option.

## **Key Details:**

HHSC directs STAR, STAR Health, STAR Kids and STAR+PLUS MCOs to allow FMSAs to suspend providing face to face orientations for CDS employers **through January 31, 2022\***.

FMSAs should provide employer orientations that are scheduled **through January 31**, **2022**\* virtually or by telephone.

Effective February 1, 2022, FMSAs can permanently conduct new employer orientation virtually (i.e. audio-visual) in addition to allowing in-person orientations, based on member preference. A new MCO Notice with updated guidance and more detailed information will be posted to TexConnect soon.

Additionally, HHSC reminds MCOs to ensure that all CDS employers have a service backup plan in place, as required by CDS rules in the Texas Administrative Code (TAC) and STAR Kids and STAR+PLUS handbooks.
