The selected **SMART Room Scholarship** recipient will receive a bedroom makeover, transforming their current room into a SMART Room - a safe, comfortable, personalized space containing features that the Member needs to safely live with their illness or disability, such as:

- » Personalized decor, including artwork to help make the room uniquely theirs
- » Top-tier technology, like a portable device
- » Interior design services and/or small furniture pieces

The SMART Room Scholarship is designed to create a space in which the Member can feel empowered and safe in the comfort of their own home, giving them the opportunity to grow and thrive.

WHO CAN APPLY

To apply, you must:*

- » be a current Community First Health Plans STAR Kids Member, and
- » be between the ages of 5 to 18, and
- » agree to an in-home assessment to determine preferences and needs.
