

# Most Common Languages Spoken by Community First Members

(By county, 2024-2025)



Community First Health Plans, Inc. (Community First) operates in the Bexar service area, which includes eight counties in the state of Texas: Atascosa, Bandera, Bexar, Comal, Guadalupe, Kendall, Medina, and Wilson Counties. The total population across the Bexar service area is 2.6 million. Community First uses external data when examining total membership data, including the United States Census Tract Reference Map, the Area Deprivation Index (ADI), and County Health Rankings & Roadmaps.

Community First categorizes its service area based on non-geographical attributes including race, ethnicity, language, and others. This data was collected and analyzed directly from Members and stored in Community First's clinical platform. Community First considers communities within the Bexar Service area non-geographically based on race, ethnicity, languages, and others to create targeted interventions to eliminate health inequities.

Tables 1 through 3 below display the non-geographic attributes and composition of each county in Community First's Bexar service area.
